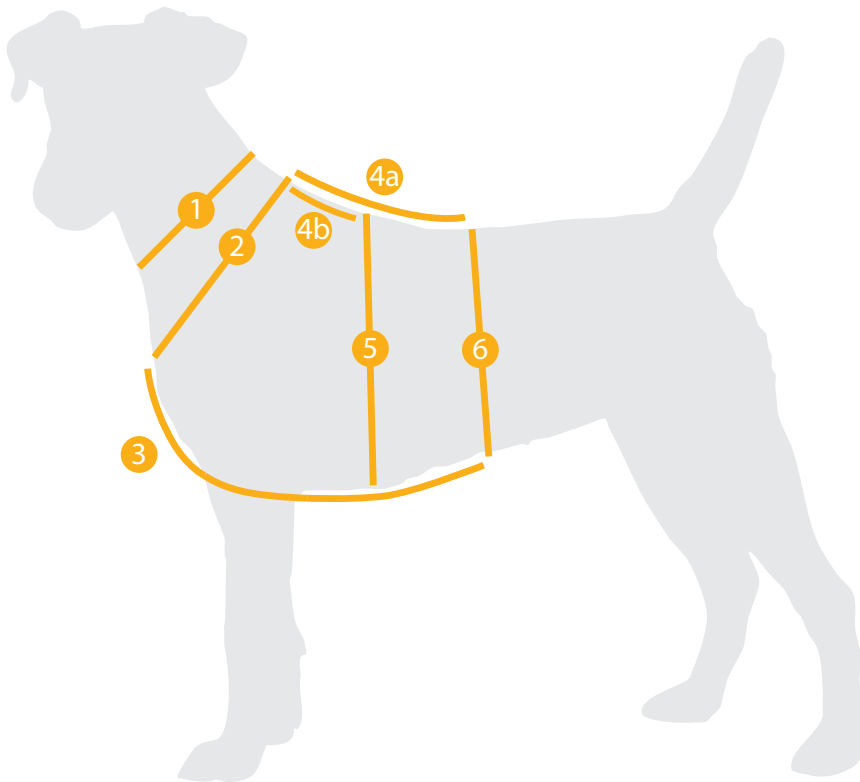
MEASURING INSTRUCTIONS FOR A NOVADOG® SAFETY EQUIPMENT

Our safety harness is suitable for dogs that panic or like to escape.

The safety of the harness is based on the second waist belt. The dog is in this way doubly secured.

To make sure, that the safety harness for your dog fits comfortably and safely, we need the following dimensions: The neck circumference, the back length, the chest circumference, the rib, the front and rear thoracic bridge, the waist circumference. Your dog should stand while measuring. A picture of the dog next to a chair would be helpful. Please measure exact and closely, we supplement the necessary „space „ during manufacture.

That's the best way to measure your dog to find the right size:



1. neck 1

Please measure the neck circumference of your dog. It is the place where the conventional dog collar would sit. Measure once around.

2. neck 2

The neck measure from the top of the sternum (breast bone) over the shoulder blades. You feel both with a slight indentation. **Please only measure one-sided!**

3. breast bridge

Measure the thoracic bridge from the top of the sternum behind the front legs. Exactly where the back length ends, the bridge must end.

4. Back length (4a, 4b)

To do this, measure the straight back measurement from the shoulder blades (indentation) to the last rib arch.

5. chest circumference

Please measure the chest size once circumference behind the front legs. For bigger dogs put the measuring tape about a hand's breadth behind the front legs, with smaller dogs two to three fingers behind the front legs.

6. waist circumference

Please measure on the last rib, once all around. Keep the tape measure tight because at this position it tends to slip.

7. breed

Please indicate breed, age of your dog and whether he has under wool.
